

Proposed Amendment to the MAAM Constitution

Proposed amendment to the Constitution wherein the following is to be inserted to Article XI of the Constitution:-

- 6) The Association shall be solely responsible for all expenditures related to any event officially sanctioned by the Executive Committee (EXCO), including but not limited to sponsorship funds, ticket sales, vendor contracts, and any other financial commitments made in the name of the Association.
- 7) No individual, including but not limited to the Organising Chairperson, the Committee Members, Volunteers, or EXCO Members shall bear personal financial liability for shortfall or non-payment of pledged sponsorships, donations or other income related to an event.
- 8) A written or electronically acknowledged pledge of sponsorship by a third party shall be deemed as a receivable of the Association. The risk of collection for such receivable rests solely with the Association.
- 9) The role of the Organising Chairperson and the Committee is to solicit sponsorships on behalf of the Association. The act of securing a pledge, once acknowledged by the sponsor, completes their core responsibility. The subsequent collection of the pledged amount is the responsibility of the EXCO and the Finance Committee.
- 10) The EXCO shall not require or compel any member or volunteer to provide a personal guarantee for event-related finances.
